

Triumphant Entry of Jesus

Luke 19:28-38

Introduction: Today I want to look at the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem.

1- The Boldness of His coming

- Enters publicly even though he is a marked man (**John 5:13-18, John 7:1**)
- Enters tearfully because of the final rejection of the people (**Matt. 23:37**)

2- The Bold declaration by His coming

- He declares that He is the Messiah

***Zechariah 9:9** Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. (v.10) And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and he shall speak peace unto the heathen: and his dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth.*

- He does not demand Praise

Yet He is praised
He will be praised

3- The Demeanor of His coming

- Not at the conquering King (As a conqueror on a white horse)
- As the humble King of Peace (As a peace maker on a donkey)

4- The Deep evidence of His coming

- His love for His Nation
- His love for the sinner
