Intro:

I. HIS APPROACH (vs 39 - 40)

- 1) The Praying Lord (John 18:2 for Jesus oftentimes resorted thither with his disciples.)
- 2) The Place of Prayer
- 3) The Prayerless disciples

II. HIS APPEAL

- 1) He falls before God
- 2) He is fully man (Matt 26:38 My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death)
- 3) He is fully God (Not my will but thine be done)

III. HIS ANGELS (vs 43)

- 1) The Saviors Angel

Ps 91:11* For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

- 2) Our Angel

Ps 34:7* The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.

2 Ki 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

IV. HIS AGONY (Vs 44)

- 1) His Earnest Prayer
- 2) His Shed Blood (Haima: blood shed, to be shed by violence, slay, murder)
- 3) The Answered Prayer
