Genesis 8:20 - 9:6

Intro: This is the third dispensation. The first two are innocency and conscience. Under both of these man ultimately failed. Innocency failed with the deception of Eve. Conscience failed with the destruction of the world by the flood. We will also fail under human government. This is the government of man by man.

I. Governments set up by God (Romans 13:1) The highest form of government is the permission given by God for man to take another's life, or the enforcement of the death penalty.
