Luke 5:1-11

- 1 Lake Gennesaret (v.1a)**
- 2 Step 1: Seeing a vision of people who need to hear the Word of God (v.1b)**
- 3 Step 2: Seizing resources (v.2-3)**
 - a. Seeing the resources available (v.2)**
 - b. Seeing a man: Simon (v.3a)**
 - c. Leading the man to serve (v.3b)**
- 4 Step 3: Removing reluctant obedience (v.4-5)**
- 5 Step 4: Demonstrating godly power (v.6-7)**
 - a. A great catch made (v.6a)**
 - b. A catch so great the net breaks (v.6b)**
 - c. A catch so great other help is needed (v.7a)**
 - d. A catch so great both boats are filled (v.7b)**
 - e. A catch so great the boats began to sink (v.7c)**
- 6 Step 5: Stirring a deep confession (v.8-9)**
 - a. Of sin (v.8a)**
 - b. Of Christ as Lord (v.8b)**
 - c. Of awe—reverence—fear (v.9)**
- 7 Step 6: Challenging men to discipleship, that is, to catch other men**
- 8 Step 7: Watching for the decision to forsake all (v.11)**
